AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; PROVIDING FOR A COUNTY JAIL SUPPORT FUND AND STATING PURPOSE THEREFOR; MAKING APPROPRIATION TO THE OKLAHOMA STATE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION; TRANSFERRING CERTAIN FUNDS; PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.27 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to be designated the "County Jail Support Fund". The fund shall be subject to legislative appropriation and shall consist of appropriated general revenue funds.

B. The County Jail Support Fund shall be used to distribute equally appropriated funds among the seventy-seven (77) counties of Oklahoma for the purpose of supporting each county's jail facilities and operations.

C. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation equally among the seventy-seven (77) counties of Oklahoma for use in maintaining and supporting each county's jail facilities and operations.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation from any monies not otherwise appropriated in the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Seven Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,700,000.00) or so much as may be necessary for the purpose of supporting county jail operations. Said appropriation shall be transferred to the County Jail Support Fund for expenditure in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of this act.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
