AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS;

AMENDING 59 O.S. 1981, SECTION 1002, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 1, CHAPTER 331, O.S.L. 1989 (59 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 1002), WHICH RELATES TO RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING PLUMBERS; AUTHORIZING STATE BOARD OF HEALTH TO ESTABLISH INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PLUMBING CONTRACTOR LICENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 1981, Section 1002, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 1989 (59 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 1002), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1002. The State Board of Health, in pursuance of its general power of supervision over the interests of the health and life of the citizens of this state, and over the sanitary conditions under which they live, is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, through the Commissioner of Health, to make, prescribe, enforce, amend and repeal rules and regulations governing the examination and licensing of persons desiring or intending to engage in the

business, trade or calling of master plumber (plumbing contractor) or journeyman plumber, the registering of and issuing of certificates to persons desiring or intending to work or act as a plumber's apprentice, and to establish bonding and insurance requirements for the issuance of a license as a plumbing contractor, provided, such rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with the terms and conditions hereinafter provided. A state bond posted pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be deemed sufficient to meet the requirements of any municipality, provided that a copy of said bond shall be filed with any municipality in which the licensee does work as a plumbing contractor. A copy of the bond shall be filed with the municipality prior to the commencement of any such work by the licensee.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
