AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; AUTHORIZING THE  
OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM AND RECREATION TO  
ESTABLISH AN INFORMATION CENTER PILOT PROJECT;  
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7071 of Title 74, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Tourism and Recreation is hereby authorized to  
establish and implement a tourist information pilot project. Said  
project will involve five (5) tourist information centers and will  
focus on a Native American and western heritage theme.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
