AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO ROADS, BRIDGES AND FERRIES;

AMENDING SECTION 5, CHAPTER 352, O.S.L. 1989 (69  
O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 689.1), WHICH RELATES TO  
THE COUNTY ROAD IMPROVEMENT ACT; ADDING STATUTORY  
REFERENCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 352, O.S.L.  
1989 (69 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 689.1), is amended to read as  
follows:

Section 689.1 Road projects constructed pursuant to the County  
Road Improvement Act, Section 657 et seq. of this title, shall meet  
acceptable design standards for local roads as developed by the  
Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma with the concurrence  
of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation. Where monies  
available pursuant to the County Road Improvement Act are used to  
match federal construction funds, road projects shall meet the  
American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials  
minimum design standards for local roads and other applicable  
federal requirements. Counties wishing to construct projects  
utilizing monies available pursuant to the County Road Improvement

Act shall formally adopt the design standards specified in this section as the official construction design standards of that county.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
