AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO ELECTIONS; AMENDING SECTION 2,
CHAPTER 296, O.S.L. 1988 (26 O.S. SUPP. 1990,
SECTION 13A-101), WHICH RELATES TO APPLICABILITY OF
GENERAL ELECTION LAWS TO SCHOOL ELECTIONS;
AUTHORIZING CERTAIN EXCEPTION REGARDING POLLING
PLACES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 296, O.S.L.
1988 (26 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 13A-101), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 13A-101. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, the
general election laws shall apply to all elections for school
districts and vocational-technical school districts. When it is
impossible or impractical to apply the general election laws for
school districts and vocational-technical school districts, the
Secretary of the State Election Board shall prescribe procedures
consistent with the purposes of the general election laws.

B. In lieu of the requirements of the general election laws
regarding location and establishment of polling places, county
election boards are hereby authorized to establish polling places

for school district and vocational-technical school district
elections at one or more school sites within the affected district
or districts.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
