AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO STATE EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING AN
EXPENSE ALLOWANCE FOR MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING OF
UNIFORMS FOR CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING AN
EXCEPTION; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 841.22A of Title 74, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

An expense allowance of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month
for maintenance and cleaning of uniforms and other related expenses
shall be paid to each employee of the State of Oklahoma who is
required to wear a uniform while performing their official duties.
This provision shall not apply to those employees specified in
Section 2-130 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
