AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; ESTABLISHING  
LIMITATIONS ON THE NUMBER OF FULL-TIME-EQUIVALENT  
EMPLOYEES AND THE SALARY OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE  
OFFICER FOR VARIOUS AGENCIES, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS,  
DEPARTMENTS OR PROGRAMS; PROVIDING FOR  
CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3601.1 of Title 74, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. For purposes of Sections 3601 through 3603 of this title,  
the term employee means a full-time employee or any number of  
part-time employees whose combined weekly hours of employment equal  
those of a full-time employee, but shall not include temporary  
employees working on a seasonal basis between May 1 and October 31.

B. The maximum number of full-time-equivalent employees for  
each of the following agencies, boards, commissions, departments, or  
programs shall not exceed the numbers specified in this section  
during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993, except as may be  
authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of

the Oklahoma Statutes. The salary of the chief executive officer for each of the following agencies, boards, commissions, departments, or programs shall not exceed the amount specified, per annum, payable monthly, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

C. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System Board of Trustees by law shall be set by the said Board of Trustees. All offices, positions and personnel of the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System shall be classified and subject to the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration as provided in the Oklahoma Personnel Act, Section 840.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, except for those offices, positions and personnel comprising the exempt unclassified service authorized in Sections 840.8 and 840.10 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and except for one (1) other position.

D. Temporary employees of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission between the dates of November 1 and January 31 annually shall not be counted toward the maximum number of full-time-equivalent employees provided for in this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
