AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO HOSPITALS AND RELATED

INSTITUTIONS; AMENDING 63 O.S. 1991, SECTIONS 1-707a AND 1-707b, WHICH RELATE TO STAFF PRIVILEGES; MODIFYING AND CLARIFYING PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA GOVERNING AND PERSONS AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE STAFF PRIVILEGES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-707a, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-707a. A. The administrator in charge of each hospital or related institution licensed by the ~~State~~ Commissioner of Health shall accept for consideration each application for staff privileges submitted by a person licensed to practice medicine by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, or by a ~~person~~ licensed to practice osteopathy by the State Board of Osteopathy or by a ~~person~~ licensed to practice podiatry by the State Board of ~~Podiatry~~ physician as defined in Section 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The application shall be acted upon by the governing board of the hospital or related institution within a reasonable time. A written report of such action shall be furnished to the applicant thereafter.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-707b, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-707b. The administrator in charge of or the governing board of each hospital or related institution licensed by the State Commissioner of Health shall adopt written criteria for use in determining which licensed ~~medical doctors, doctors of osteopathy and doctors of pediatry~~ physicians, as defined in Section 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be granted staff privileges by the hospital or related institution.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
