AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CONTROLLED INDUSTRIAL WASTE;

PROHIBITING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FROM  
ISSUING CERTAIN PERMITS FOR CONTROLLED INDUSTRIAL  
WASTE DISPOSAL AND INCINERATION FOR A CERTAIN  
PERIOD OF TIME; REQUIRING DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT  
CERTAIN STUDY AND REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE;  
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2014.4 of Title 63, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Health is hereby prohibited from issuing  
any permit for a controlled industrial waste disposal or  
incineration facility until July 1, 1994. During this moratorium  
period, the Department shall make an in-depth study of controlled  
industrial waste disposal and incineration including the effects of  
such treatment on the health and safety of the public and the

environment. The Department shall issue a report to the Legislature no later than January 1, 1994, detailing the findings of the study.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
