AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE; AMENDING 56

O.S. 1991, SECTION 166, WHICH RELATES TO
APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE; PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN
APPLICANTS FOR ASSISTANCE WILL BE INELIGIBLE FOR
FUTURE ASSISTANCE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES;
PROVIDING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES
WILL PROVIDE CERTAIN PROCEDURE TO CERTAIN
APPLICANTS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND PROVIDING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 1991, Section 166, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 166. A. Application for assistance under this act
shall be made to the county department of the county in which the
applicant resides. The application shall be in writing, signed by
the applicant or legal guardian and shall be in a manner and upon
the form prescribed by the State Department.

B. Any applicant for assistance under this act, who has
children or is pregnant at the time of application, shall not be
eligible for assistance for any future children. Provided, the
Department of Human Services shall provide free of charge to any

applicant for assistance under this act a tubal ligation if so
requested by the applicant.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
