AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO WASTE TIRE RECYCLING; ELIMINATING
REQUIREMENT FOR WASTE TIRE FACILITIES COLLECTION OF
CERTAIN TIRES; STATING EXCEPTION; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 53008.1 of Title 68, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Nothing in this act shall require waste tire facilities to
collect or process any discarded vehicle tire for which a waste tire
recycling fee has not been assessed against the tire sold as a
replacement for or exchanged for the discarded vehicle tire.

Provided, however, the provisions of this section shall not apply to
any tire located at any tire dump certified by the State Department
of Health's enforcement priority list.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
