SENATE BILL NO. 841

AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO LABOR; LIMITING CERTAIN INCREASES  
IN CERTAIN CONTRIBUTION RATES; AUTHORIZING  
NONIMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION UNDER CERTAIN  
CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-115 of Title 40, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Contribution rates determined pursuant to the Employment  
Security Act of 1980, Article 3, Part 1, of this title, shall be  
limited to an increase of two percent (2%) a year until the maximum  
rate is attained.

If this section is determined by a delegate of the Secretary of  
the United States Department of Labor to be inconsistent with  
federal law, the Commission with concurrence of the State Attorney  
General is authorized to prohibit the implementation of this  
section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 1993.
