AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE; AMENDING 56

O.S. 1991, SECTION 166, WHICH RELATES TO  
APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE; PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN  
APPLICANTS SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE  
UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; REQUIRING THE  
DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN  
PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 1991, Section 166, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 166. A. Application for assistance under this act  
shall be made to the county department of the county in which the  
applicant resides. The application shall be in writing, signed by  
the applicant or legal guardian and shall be in a manner and upon  
the form prescribed by the State Department.

B. Any applicant for assistance under the Aid to Families With  
Dependent Children Program who has children or is pregnant at the  
time of application shall not be eligible for assistance related to  
any subsequent pregnancy.

C. The Department of Human Services shall establish a program  
to provide participants in the Aid to Families With Dependent

Children Program with educational materials on birth control  
methods.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
