AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO NONINTOXICATING BEVERAGES;

MODIFYING REFERENCE TO CERTAIN TERM; PROVIDING FOR

CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 240 of Title 37, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Whenever reference is made in the Oklahoma Statutes to the term "nonintoxicating beverages", it shall be deemed to refer to Class A alcohol beverages.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
