AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT; AMENDING 40 O.S. 1991, SECTION 482, WHICH RELATES TO FUNDING OF THE JOBS RECOVERY PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING APPOINTMENT OF ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON IMPLEMENTATION AND EXPANSION OF PROGRAM AND ON CREATION OF OKLAHOMA PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS AUTHORITY; REQUIRING EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION TO SUBMIT CERTAIN REPORT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 1991, Section 482, is amended to read as follows:

Section 482. A. The Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall seek any federal funds available for the implementation of the Jobs Recovery Program, including, but not limited to, funds available from grants or work and training programs.

B. The Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall seek any private sector funds available for the implementation of the Jobs Recovery Program, including, but not limited to, funds available from donations or grants.

C. The executive director of the Commission is hereby authorized to appoint an advisory committee which shall make recommendations to the executive director on the implementation of the Jobs Recovery Program, expansion of the Program and creation of an Oklahoma Public Works Projects Authority. The executive director shall submit a report of the committee's findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on the first day of the First Regular Session of the Forty-fourth Oklahoma Legislature.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
