AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH CARE; AUTHORIZING ONLY

CERTAIN PERSONS TO PERFORM LASER SURGERY; PROVIDING

FOR CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 731.8 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Only persons licensed pursuant to the laws of this state to practice medicine, osteopathic medicine, veterinary medicine, dentistry or podiatry shall perform laser surgery.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
