AN ACT RELATING TO CIVIL RIGHTS; AMENDING 25 O.S.

1991, SECTION 1101, WHICH RELATES TO PURPOSES AND
CONSTRUCTION OF ACT; CLARIFYING LANGUAGE; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 1991, Section 1101, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1101. A. The general purposes of this act are ~~to~~:

1. To provide for execution within the state of the policies
embodied in the federal Civil Rights Act of 1964, 28 U.S.C., Section
1447, the federal Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, 29
U.S.C., Section 621 et seq., and Section 504 of the federal
Rehabilitation Act of 1973 ~~to~~, 29 U.S.C., Section 701 et seq.;

2. To make uniform the law of those states which enact this
act, ~~;~~ and ~~to~~

3. To provide rights and remedies substantially equivalent to
those granted under the federal Fair Housing Law.

B. This act shall be construed according to the fair import of
its terms and shall be liberally construed to further the general

purposes stated in this section and the special purposes of the particular provision involved.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
