AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING 47 O.S.

1991, SECTIONS 11-801c AND 11-801d, WHICH RELATE TO
RESTRICTIONS ON RECORDING POINTS FOR SPEEDING
VIOLATIONS; LIMITING IN-STATE AND OUT-OF-STATE
RECORDED VIOLATION POINTS TO CERTAIN SPEED LIMIT;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 11-801c, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-801c. The Oklahoma Department of Public Safety shall not record or assess points for traffic violations or convictions for traffic offenses on any licensee's traffic record as maintained by said Department, where such violation or conviction is for exceeding the posted speed limit ~~specified in this act, but not exceeding the speed limit previously in force where the violation occurred~~ by five (5) miles per hour or less.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 11-801d, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-801d. The Department of Public Safety shall not record or assess points against a licensee for out-of-state violations or convictions of exceeding such state's posted speed limits, ~~provided such licensee did not exceed the speed limit previously in force as of January 1, 1974, in the state where the violation or conviction occurred~~ by five (5) miles per hour or less.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective January 1, 1993.
