AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO OIL AND GAS; CREATING THE OKLAHOMA
INDEPENDENT ENERGY RESOURCES ACT; PROVIDING SHORT
TITLE; CREATING THE OKLAHOMA INDEPENDENT ENERGY
RESOURCES BOARD; STATING PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 701 of Title 52, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Energy
Education and Marketing Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 702 of Title 52, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created the Oklahoma Independent Energy
Resources Board for the purpose of coordinating a program designed
to demonstrate to the general public the importance of the
independent oil and gas exploration and production industry within
the State of Oklahoma, to encourage the wise and efficient use of
energy, to promote environmentally sound production methods and
technologies, to develop the State of Oklahoma's existing supplies
of oil and gas and additional markets for natural gas, and to

support research and educational activities concerning the independent oil and gas exploration and production industry.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
