AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; REQUIRING PARTICIPATION OF CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES IN A MANAGEMENT TRAINING PROGRAM; REQUIRING CERTAIN CERTIFICATION FOR OBTAINING OR RETAINING CERTAIN POSITIONS; PROVIDING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RETENTION OF CERTIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840.5c of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Except for elected officials, each appointing authority, supervisor and other person with any managerial responsibilities in any agency of this state shall participate annually in a management training program as developed in cooperation with the Office of Personnel Management.

Except for elected officials, after January 1, 1993, no appointing authority, supervisor or other person with any managerial responsibilities shall obtain a supervisory or managerial position

or remain in a supervisory or managerial position with any agency of this state unless such person has been certified as a "certified public manager" by the Office of Personnel Management. Each certified public manager must participate in the annual management training program in order to remain certified.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
