AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO STATE EMPLOYEES; CREATING THE
EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM WITHIN THE OFFICE OF
PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT; STATING PURPOSE; PROVIDING
FOR CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7101 of Title 74, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created an Employee Assistance Program within
the Office of Personnel Management for the purpose of assisting
state agencies in their management of employees whose personal
problems have a negative impact on job performance. The Employee
Assistance Program shall make referrals and assist employees with
various types of assistance for a multitude of personal problems
which affect the employees life and work performance including
marital or parent/child/family problems, alcohol/drug abuse, mental
health problems, work-related problems and financial problems.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
