AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY; AMENDING
63 O.S. 1991, SECTION 1-731, WHICH RELATES TO
ABORTIONS; SPECIFYING LOCATIONS FOR CERTAIN
PROCEDURES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-731, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-731. A. No person shall perform or induce an abortion upon a pregnant woman unless that person is a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Oklahoma and such abortion is performed or induced in a facility licensed by the State Department of Health to operate in the State of Oklahoma or in the office of a doctor licensed pursuant to Section 481 et seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Any person violating this section shall be guilty of a felony punishable by not less than one (1) year nor more than three (3) years in the State Penitentiary.

B. No person shall perform or induce an abortion upon a pregnant woman subsequent to the end of the first trimester of her pregnancy, unless such abortion is performed or induced in a general hospital.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
