AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO THE OKLAHOMA PLANNING COUNCIL FOR
DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES; REQUIRING THE GOVERNOR
TO GIVE CERTAIN CONSIDERATION IN MAKING CERTAIN
APPOINTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1426 of Title 10, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In appointing the membership of the Oklahoma Planning Council
for Developmental Disabilities, in addition to any other
considerations required by federal legislation, the Governor shall
give consideration to making said appointments broadly
representative of the four geographic areas of the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
