AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR STATE
AGENCIES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE STATE BOARD
OF EDUCATION, THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
SERVICES AND THE STATE EMERGENCY FUND; STATING
PURPOSES; PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
_____ Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of
_____ Dollars (\$____.00) or so much thereof as may be
necessary for supplements in State Aid to school districts for the
1991-92 school year as provided in subsection C of Section 18-200 of
Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the _____ Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Human Services by law.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Emergency Fund created pursuant to Section 139.42 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the _____ Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for state emergencies.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
