AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO THE OKLAHOMA WATER RESOURCES

BOARD; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO; PROVIDING
PURPOSES; PROVIDING A LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board from any monies in the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993, the sum of Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$215,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to develop a comprehensive groundwater management strategy.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1993. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1993, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
