AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE BOARD OF VOCATIONAL AND  
TECHNICAL EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTION 4, CHAPTER  
281, O.S.L. 1991, WHICH RELATES TO BUDGETARY  
LIMITATIONS FOR THE STATE BOARD OF VOCATIONAL AND  
TECHNICAL EDUCATION; MODIFYING BUDGETARY  
LIMITATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 281, O.S.L.  
1991, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education by law  
shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Director of the State  
Department of Vocational and Technical Education shall not exceed  
Seventy-two Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$72,920.00) per  
annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992.  
The State Board of Vocational and Technical Education for the fiscal  
year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following

budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
