AS INTRODUCED

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MAY AS "MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH" IN THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, motorcycles are an energy efficient and key means of transportation and a source of recreation; and  
WHEREAS, over five million persons own and operate motorcycles nationwide; and  
WHEREAS, it is essential that motorcyclists practice and utilize sound riding and safety skills; and  
WHEREAS, rider education programs such as those offered by ABATE (A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education), a statewide organization, promote public awareness of the proper and safe use of motorcycles and deserve recognition by the Oklahoma State Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the month of May, 1991, is hereby proclaimed "Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month" in the State of Oklahoma.
