1687, 1688, 1689, as amended by Section 2, Chapter
251, O.S.L. 1993, 1692, 1694, as amended by Section
5, Chapter 236, O.S.L. 1993, 1695, as amended by
Section 6, Chapter 236, O.S.L. 1993 and 1696 (59
O.S. Supp. 1993, Sections 1681, 1689, 1694 and
1695), which relate to the Electrical License Act;
authorizing the State Board of Health to adopt,
repeal or modify rules relating to continuing
education; adding definition; modifying definition;
modifying the membership of the Committee of
Electrical Examiners; prohibiting membership under
certain conditions; modifying duties of the
nonvoting member; authorizing the Department to
administer certain examinations under certain
conditions; providing for officers of the
Committee; providing for terms, powers and duties
of such officers; providing for meetings; modifying
and adding certain fees; prohibiting renewal of a
license except under certain conditions; placing a

time limit on certain certificates; authorizing certain reregistration; changing the name of the Electrical Hearing Board to the Electrical Appeals and Hearing Board; modifying certain requirements not applicable under the act; correcting reference; requiring warning before a person is subject to certain administrative fines; modifying authority over certain electrical facilities; limiting jurisdiction of cities and towns; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 5, Section 4, lines 24 and 28, after the word "Apprentice" delete the word "License" and insert the word

"Registration"

in both places

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 8, line 11 through line 6 on page 9, delete all of Section 7,

and renumber subsequent sections

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 10, Section 9, lines 10 through 16, after the "period" on line 10 and before the word "All" on line 16 delete all language

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 1, amend the title to read
