A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article 24 of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; deleting requirement that the Legislature submit a proposed Constitutional Convention to the people every twenty years; calling a Constitutional Convention to alter, revise, or amend the present Constitution of the State of Oklahoma or to propose a new Constitution; fixing the time and place thereof; providing for representation to the Convention and election of delegates; providing qualifications and duties of delegates; requiring the Governor to appoint delegates if vacancies occur; providing for election of officers and organization; providing for compensation of delegates; providing for submission of constitutional changes to the voters of the state; providing ballot titles; and directing filing.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, line 18 through page 5, line 12, delete all language and renumber subsequent section

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 5, Section 13, lines 15 and 16, after the comma on line 15, and before the comma on line 16, delete all language and insert

"including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2 hereof"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, in the title, lines 11 1/2 through 17, delete all language through the first semicolon on line 17

and on line 17, delete the word "titles" and insert the word "title"
