A Joint Resolution requiring acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS) prevention education; providing for more specific requirements for such education; specifying criteria for AIDS education classes; requiring AIDS prevention education to emphasize certain points; providing for applicable staff development for teachers and administrators; directing distribution; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, Section 2, line 31, after the word "diseases" and before the semicolon insert a period and the words

". Information explaining the effectiveness of condoms in the prevention of sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) sufficient to provide a range of effectiveness of such devices shall be included in teacher in-service training and classroom AIDS instruction periods. The range of condom effectiveness should be shown by citing not less than ten (10) studies conducted using meta-analysis and recognized by the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, line 8, strike the title to read

criteria for classes - staff development for  
teachers and administrators -  
directing distribution ]"
