COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to game and fish; requiring special licenses for hunting and fishing on lands leased or administered by the Department of Wildlife Conservation; providing for fees; providing exceptions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-125A of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. On and after January 1, 1995, the Oklahoma Wildlife Commission may establish a special license required of all persons who hunt or fish on private lands leased and otherwise administered by the Department.

B. The Commission may assess an annual license fee for hunting and fishing on such Department-leased land. Such fee shall not exceed Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00). Any fees collected pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be expended by the Department exclusively for developing, managing, preserving and protecting wildlife and wildlife habitat on those lands leased for such purposes.

C. Persons under eighteen (18) years of age or sixty-four (64) years of age or older shall be exempt from the licensure required by this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
