COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to torts; declaring public policy;
providing certain immunity from civil liability;
providing for codification; and providing an effective
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 31 of Title 76, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It is hereby declared to be the public policy of the State
of Oklahoma that a person convicted of a felony should not recover
from the victim any compensation for injuries the felon may have
received during the commission of that felony.

B. A victim of a crime owes no duty of care to the
perpetrator of the crime. A victim shall be immune from any civil
liability for injuries to a convicted felon resulting from the
commission of a felony by that felon.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
