COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 1991, Section 697.6, which relates to the Physician Manpower Training Commission; redefining certain rural participation program; requiring the Commission to promulgate and adopt certain rules relating to such program; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 697.6, is amended to read as follows:

Section 697.6 Funds appropriated to carry out the provisions of this act shall be allocated so that ~~the percentage~~ no less than forty percent (40%) of all participating residents and interns ~~located outside Oklahoma City and Tulsa will be no less than forty percent (40%) during the 1981-1982 school year and ensuing school years~~ in each school year must participate in a rural program outside the Oklahoma City and Tulsa metropolitan areas. The Physician Manpower Training Commission, in accordance with primary care specialty accreditation standards, shall promulgate and adopt rules designating the time allocation spent by the residents and interns participating in this program outside the Oklahoma City and Tulsa metropolitan areas.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
