COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to arrest warrant information; directing the Office of Administrative Director of the Courts to provide computerized arrest warrant identification information to the Department of Public Safety; stating purpose; authorizing the Administrative Director of the Courts to conduct certain audits; providing certain immunity; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-124.1 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Office of the Administrative Director of the Courts shall provide to the Department of Public Safety current computerized arrest warrant identification information for dissemination to the users of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication Systems.

B. The Office of the Administrative Director of the Courts shall have the authority to audit state and local law enforcement agencies to ensure compliance with applicable state and federal laws.

C. No cause of action shall arise, nor shall any liability be imposed against any personnel within the Office of the Administrative Director of the Courts or the district courts or any personnel of the Department of Public Safety for communicating or delivering information or data pursuant to the provisions of this section, if such communication or delivery was performed in

good faith and without fraudulent intent and in accordance with the established standards and guidelines.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
