COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by adding a new section to Article V to be designated as Section 46A; prohibiting the Legislature from imposing certain employer contributions except under certain circumstances; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Article V of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 46A to read as follows:

Section 46A. No employer contributions shall be imposed on employers in this state who pay contributions as defined under the Employment Security Act of 1980, if such contribution diverts any funds which would otherwise be deposited in the Unemployment Compensation Fund as established in the Employment Security Act of 1980.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure adds a new section to the Oklahoma Constitution.

This new section is 46A of Article V. It does not allow any

contribution to be put on employers if it would divert funds  
which would go into the Unemployment Compensation Fund.  
SHALL THIS AMENDMENT BE APPROVED BY THE PEOPLE?

SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,  
immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare  
and file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in  
SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with  
the Attorney General.
