COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public finance; establishing pilot initiative for certain agencies; providing for program budgeting; designating agencies directed to participate; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 41.44 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There shall be established a pilot initiative for select departments, agencies, boards and commissions, hereinafter referred to as pilot agencies, to prepare, submit and operate their budgetary system in a program format. The following pilot agencies are directed to participate in the program budgeting pilot: Oklahoma Educational Television Authority, Physician Manpower Training Commission, Department of Vocational and Technical Education, Department of the Commissioner of the Land Office, Department of Corrections, Department of Public Safety, Office of Personnel Management, Office of State Finance, Department of Central Services, State Department of Agriculture, Water Resources Board, Department of Commerce, Department of

Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, and the Commission on Children and Youth.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
