COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to oil and gas; providing for filing of certain affidavit regarding forced poolings; stating content of affidavit and requiring attachment of certain order; providing for filing by certain persons; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 87.4 of Title 52, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

An affidavit of elections under a pooling order issued pursuant to the proceedings set out in subsection (e) of Section 87.1 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall constitute constructive notice of the rights under the elections claimed by the affiant when the affidavit is filed of record in the office of the county clerk for the county in which the lands described in the pooling order are located. The affidavit shall set out the names, addresses and elections, including deemed elections, of all respondents named in the pooling order and shall have a file-stamped copy of the pooling order attached. The affidavit may be filed by the operator designated in the pooling order or by any other interested party with knowledge of elections made.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take

effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
