3RD CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 1121, which relates to dishonored checks received by motor license agents; deleting certain motor license agent duties; providing procedures for handling dishonored checks for driver's licenses; requiring motor license agents to transmit dishonored checks to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and the Department of Public Safety; requiring credit to certain accounts; authorizing the Oklahoma Tax Commission to contract for collection of certain dishonored checks; authorizing motor license agents to collect certain fees and providing an exception; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 1121, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1121. A. When, at the time of registration of any vehicle, payment is made by check for fees and taxes and the check is not paid by the bank on which drawn for any reason, after said check has been presented for payment a second time, such certificate of registration and other such instruments issued at the time of registration of such vehicle shall be invalid ~~and shall be canceled immediately, without notice, by the motor license agent who issued such registration certificate.~~ The motor license agent shall transmit all documents and the dishonored check to the Oklahoma Tax Commission for credit to the motor license agent's account. The Commission may enter into a contract for the collection of dishonored checks and canceled instruments. In all such cases, such vehicles shall be subject to the license fees and penalties provided in this act as though no attempt to

register the vehicle had been made and the motor license agent shall charge the person issuing the check a fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each check to cover the costs of processing each returned check; ~~provided:~~.

~~1. Such charge shall not be made unless efforts have been made to present such check for payment a second time; and~~

~~2. A mortgagee who repossesses any such vehicle shall not be required, as a condition for registration of said vehicle, to pay the dishonored check penalties which had accrued as of the date of such repossession.~~

B. Whenever payment is made by check for any Oklahoma driver's license and the check is not paid by the bank on which drawn for any reason, after said check has been presented for payment a second time, such driver's license shall be invalid and all driving privileges of the holder of the driver's license shall be canceled. The motor license agent shall transmit the dishonored check to the Oklahoma Tax Commission for credit to the motor license agents account. The Commission may enter into a contract for the collection of dishonored checks. The motor license agent shall charge the person issuing the check a fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each check to cover the cost of processing each returned check. The motor license agent shall transmit a copy of all documents associated with the application and issuance of the driver's license and a copy of the dishonored check to the Department of Public Safety.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
