BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE ARTS COUNCIL

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council. The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed Forty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$41,820.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994. The State Arts Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
