An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
designating Interstate Highway 40-Business as the
"Roger Miller Memorial Highway"; providing for the
Oklahoma Department of Transportation to place
permanent markers; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1622 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Interstate Highway 40-Business from westbound exit number 11 on Interstate Highway 40 west near Erick to State Highway 30 shall be designated the "Roger Miller Memorial Highway" as a lasting tribute to the "King of the Road" Roger Miller, a favorite son from Erick. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing said name.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
