An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring certain persons to meet certain statutory requirements related to driver license; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-208.2 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Public Safety shall require any person having more than one suspension, revocation, or other departmental action affecting their driving privileges to meet the statutory requirements for each action, including payment of applicable reinstatement fees as a condition precedent to the reinstatement of any driving privilege.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
