A Concurrent Resolution honoring the health care facilities management team; designating the fourth week in October of each year as "National Health Care Facilities Management Week" in the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, health care facilities management is the diverse practice of managing the physical, technological, and support services of health care facilities, integrating the principles of planning, operations, and business management with the engineering and medical sciences to create and preserve a safe and effective environment that supports the mission of the health care organization; and

WHEREAS, the health care facilities management team is multifaceted and includes maintenance, facilities and plant engineering, construction and renovation, buildings and grounds, biomedical equipment, fire safety, general safety, facility planning, waste management, clinical engineering, environmental issues, architecture and design, security and facility support services personnel; and

WHEREAS, the health care facilities management team has never been adequately recognized or honored. This is the first year that the American Society for Hospital Engineering has sponsored a special week honoring the facilities management team.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature honors the health care  
facilities management team.

THAT the fourth week in October of each year shall be designated  
as "National Health Care Facilities Management Week" in the State of  
Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma  
Association of Hospital Engineers and the American Society for  
Hospital Engineering.
