RESOLUTION NO. 34

A Concurrent Resolution relating to pollution prevention recognition program; requiring the Department of Environmental Quality to create a program to award certain entities for significant pollution prevention efforts; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, during the meetings of the Joint Interim Committee on Incentives for Pollution Prevention, one suggestion proposed is the need for the State of Oklahoma to promote and encourage pollution prevention efforts in private industry and within the public sector; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature proposes a program to recognize companies and governmental entities for their efforts to reduce waste streams, reduce the use of hazardous materials, develop source reduction, waste minimization and recycling programs and other activities designed to prevent pollution and protect the environment and natural resources of the State of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT it is the desire of the Oklahoma Legislature that the Department of Environmental Quality create within that Department a program designed to publicly recognize and award private companies and governmental entities who have made significant strides in incorporating pollution prevention measures within their organizations.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor of the State of Oklahoma, the Secretary of Environment and the Executive Director of the Department of Environmental Quality.
