A Concurrent Resolution directing the Office of State Finance to continue a feasibility study of the practicality of consolidating contracts for data processing subscription services and consolidated data processing maintenance services; requiring a report; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Office of State Finance has been directed to undertake a feasibility study on the practicality of consolidating contracts for data processing subscription services and consolidated data processing maintenance services; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the study has resulted in the need for additional time to accomplish the purposes of the study; and

WHEREAS, the study is critical to the decisions relating to a plan for implementation of such consolidated services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Office of State Finance is hereby directed to continue the feasibility study concerning consolidated contracts for data processing subscription services and consolidated data processing maintenance services as directed in Section 6 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 391 of the 1st Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature.

THAT the Director of State Finance, by December 1, 1994 shall submit a report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the

Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives detailing the results of the study, and, if appropriate, shall propose a plan for implementation of such consolidated services.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Director of the Office of State Finance.
