AWARD WINNER JOHN SMITH; DECLARING AMATEUR WRESTLING WEEK;
PROVIDING FOR A JOHN SMITH DAY; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the Amateur Athletic Union annually presents the prestigious James E. Sullivan Award to the nation's outstanding amateur athlete; and

WHEREAS, Del City's John Smith, a four-time finalist for the award, became the first wrestler and the first Oklahoman to receive this highest of honors; and

WHEREAS, this tribute is but the latest in a long line of awards and victories earned by John Smith, considered to be the best amateur wrestler in the world; and

WHEREAS, John Smith's supremacy in the wrestling world is illustrated by his four world championships and designation as "Master of Technique", an honor given to the world's best technical wrestler; and

WHEREAS, the measure of a man is not only what he has accomplished, but what he contributes, and John Smith has contributed much to the sport of amateur wrestling, bringing to it prestige, as well as providing a positive role model for all Oklahomans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT John Smith, the world's greatest amateur wrestler, is hereby commended and praised for winning the coveted James E. Sullivan Award as the nation's outstanding amateur athlete.

THAT the week during which the 1992 NCAA Wrestling Tournament is held is hereby declared to be Amateur Wrestling Week in Oklahoma in honor of Oklahoma's proud tradition of wrestling excellence.

THAT the first day of Amateur Wrestling Week is hereby declared to be John Smith Day, in honor of the world's greatest amateur wrestler.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to John Smith, the 1990 Sullivan Award recipient.
