A Concurrent Resolution proclaiming the week of April 25 through May 1, 1993, "Oklahoma Science and Technology Week"; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma has improved its national ranking through excellence and innovation in science and technology research and development and has had the foresight to create the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology and the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics to ensure our continued success and to augment the long-standing efforts of our colleges and universities and other agencies in this vibrant field; and

WHEREAS, Oklahomans have excelled in science and technology in the areas of biotechnology, manufacturing, engineering, the petroleum industry, agriculture, aerospace and many other areas; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma is successfully attracting a much larger share of private and federal research funds due to a commitment to science and technology through aerospace, manufacturing, engineering, agriculture, biotechnology, petroleum and other areas; and

WHEREAS, every day Oklahomans benefit from the technological breakthroughs made possible by our state's commitment to scientific research and technological innovation; and

WHEREAS, science and technology are focal points of a renewed commitment to education for Oklahoma's public schools and for higher education and Oklahoma public school students are joining students from across the nation in advancing their knowledge in science and technology by participating in National Science and Technology Week; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma is looked to as a model by other states and countries for their programs supporting the science and technology process; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of this great state are supporting science and technology with the same pioneering spirit which propelled our forefathers when settling this great land we now call Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the week of April 25 through May 1, 1993, is hereby declared "Oklahoma Science and Technology Week 1993".

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the President of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the State Board of Education.
