A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Commission for Human Services to enter into certain lease/purchase agreement for certain office space; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires the board of county commissioners of each county to furnish quarters for local units of the Department of Human Services unless it is determined that adequate or suitable quarters from the county are not available or obtainable; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Lincoln County, Oklahoma, does not have adequate resources to meet its legal obligation; and

WHEREAS, Lincoln County, Oklahoma, in conjunction with the City of Chandler and local banks, is undertaking a project via the Lincoln County Industrial Development Authority to provide office space to the Department of Human Services which it will lease to the Department; and

WHEREAS, at the end of the lease period, the Department of Human Services will have an option to purchase the office building; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the lease/purchase arrangement will result in substantial savings to the Department and provide much needed space and central offices to handle the social services needs in Lincoln County for years to come; and

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires that this type of transaction must receive legislative approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT in order to offer accessible and comprehensive services to clients of the Department of Human Services from Lincoln County, the Commission for Human Services is authorized to enter into a lease/purchase agreement with the Lincoln County Industrial Development Authority to provide office space to the Department of Human Services for the location of a county office of the Department in Lincoln County.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Commission for Human Services and the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Oklahoma.
