RESOLUTION NO. 1061 By: Gray, Sadler, Stanley, Hilliard and Mass

A Resolution directing the Speaker of the House of Representatives to appoint an Interim Study Committee on Dental Services.

WHEREAS, there is a pressing need to review and evaluate the State Dental Act and rules which affect the relationship between and the scope of practice of dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants and denturists; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Legislature to examine the need to determine whether various practices need to be regulated and the extent of regulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT by July 1, 1994, the Speaker of the House of Representatives appoint an Interim Study Committee to be composed of eight (8) members as follows: Four members shall be members of the House of Representatives, one shall be a dentist, one shall be a dental hygienist, one shall be a dental assistant and one shall be a denturist.

THAT the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one legislator as chairman and one lay member as vice-chairman.

THAT the Study Committee shall conduct its review during the 1994 interim of the Oklahoma Legislature.

THAT the Study Committee shall consider and evaluate the present governance arrangements and such proposed forms of governance for the respective members of the dental team as the Study Committee deems appropriate and shall identify such other problems if as the Study Committee deems appropriate to the delivery of dental services.

THAT the Study Committee shall report its findings and recommendations as agreed upon by the majority of the Study Committee members to the Speaker of the House of Representatives by January 1, 1995.
