An Act relating to motor vehicles; directing the  
Department of Public Safety to promulgate certain  
rules relating to reinstatement of driving  
privilege; authorizing payment schedule for certain  
fees; providing for codification; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-208.3 of Title 47, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules and  
establish and implement procedures whereby any person whose driving  
privileges have been suspended or revoked, when such person is  
eligible to apply for reinstatement of such privileges, may pay in  
installment payments the reinstatement fees required by law. The  
driving privileges of such person shall not be reinstated until the  
required fees are paid in full and such person has met all other  
requirements for reinstatement; provided, however, the suspension or  
revocation may be modified as provided by law during the period in  
which the installment payments are being made if all other  
requirements for reinstatement have been met.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
