AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring Department of Public Safety to promulgate rules for certain motorcycle safety programs; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-101.2 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Public Safety shall prescribe, adopt and promulgate rules necessary for the certification of programs for motorcycle safety and education offered by other public or private organizations. Such rules shall be promulgated in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, Section 250 et seq. of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
